

Otonga Road Primary School Cricket 2018 – Term 4



Dear Parents/Caregivers

This notice is for all parents of children (year 1-6 boys and girls) who are interested in playing Cricket in Term 4 this year.

Superstar Academy, Super Six, and Incrediball: Cricket will begin for Term 4 with a registration day to be held on the 18th October 2018 and will run through to (and including) the 6th December 2018. These will be played at Smallbone Park, every Thursday starting at 3:30pm to approximately 5:30pm.

Superstar Academy (Year 1 and 2): Fees = \$20. This will be a fun mix of cricket skills and modified games designed to enthuse the youngsters about playing cricket. At this level the children are not put into teams and no parent coaches are required, but help on the day is always appreciated. No uniform is required.

Super Six Cricket (Year 2 and 3): Fees = \$30. Teams of six participate in a 'Kiwi' cricket style game. All children get a bowl and a bat. Parent helpers are needed at this level. There will be lots of support from the Rotorua Cricket Association with coaching ideas etc. All gear is supplied. The school shirt (can be ordered from Embroidme) and royal blue shorts are required for this level.

Incrediball Cricket (Year 4 to 6): Fees = \$30. Teams of eight participate in a game. It is designed for older children or those with a bit of experience. Parent coaches are needed at this level and all gear is supplied. The school shirt (can be ordered from Embroidme) and Royal blue shorts are required for this level.

Hardball Cricket (Year 5 and 6): Fees = \$30. For experienced players. Teams of 8 playing, using all the proper gear. Long white pants and the school shirt will need to be purchased. Parent coaches are needed at this level as well as helpers to score on the day. This will begin on Saturday 27th October and will run through to (an including) the 15th December 2018. The games will be held at either Puarenga Park or Tokoroa Memorial Sports Ground every Saturday morning starting at 8:30am to approximately 12pm.

Registrations need to be completed before Friday 14th September 2018. (No late entries will be accepted).

A local company, **Embroidme** have designed a lovely shirt for us. You need to order directly from them. Your child can play in 'mufti' while you are waiting for your shirt. The Otonga sports shirt will cost \$35. Their contact details are: Embroidme at 1198 Arawa Street – Phone 3491000. We do have some second hand shirts available at school for use - please see Mr Walden in Room 14 about these. **Any royal blue shorts are accepted.**

Please consider helping out with a team. (Even if you know nothing about cricket!) There is lots of support on the day. If we don't have enough coaches/helpers unfortunately some children may miss out and money refunded.



This year we are using KINDO for Cricket registrations and payments. Registrations can be completed online through Kindo. Kindo accepts Debit and Credit cards, POLi Internet Banking or you can access bank details for standard internet or phone banking (see "top up account" once logged in). Details on how to register and pay using Kindo are below:

left-hand side. The 4 Cricket options (Superstar Academy, Super Six, Incrediball and Hardball) will then appear on the main 'action required' screen. Click on Cricket option that best suits the age and skill of your child and follow the steps outlined at the bottom of the 'detail' pop-up box.
